Quantitative Observations vs. Qualitative Observations

Quantitative Observations - Having to do with quantity. Counting the number of items attached to an object. Capable of being measured. Example: There are 6 legs on a grasshopper.

N = Number

Qualitative Observations - Having to do with the quality or characteristics of an object. Using your 5 senses to describe an object.

Example: The rock is rough.



QuaLitative L = Look
