
• <u>Echo</u>- A sound wave that reflects off a surface and back to its source



• <u>Sound Reflection</u>- Sound waves easily reflect off the smooth, hard surfaces



• <u>Sound Absorption</u>- Sound waves are taken in by soft materials with irregular shapes



- Echolocation Finding things by sending out sound waves that reflect off of an object
- <u>Sonar</u>- A type of electronic echolocation. *It stands for Sound Navigation and Ranging.*
- <u>Ultrasonic</u> too high pitched for the human ear to hear
