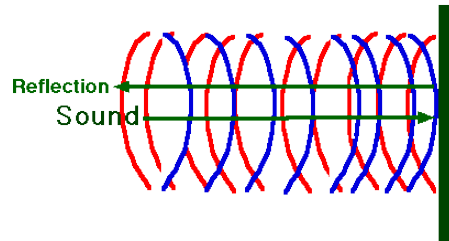
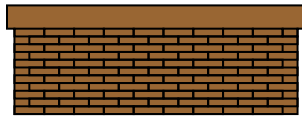


- **Echo**- A sound wave that reflects off a surface and back to its source



- **Sound Reflection**- Sound waves easily reflect off the smooth, hard surfaces



- **Sound Absorption**- Sound waves are taken in by soft materials with irregular shapes



- **Echolocation**- Finding things by sending out sound waves that reflect off of an object
- **Sonar**- A type of electronic echolocation. *It stands for Sound Navigation and Ranging.*
- **Ultrasonic** - too high pitched for the human ear to hear
